## Teaching Artist, Cello

### Description

Portsmouth Music and Arts Center seeks a dedicated music educator and experienced cello teaching artist to recruit and maintain a teaching studio for students ages 7-18 and adults. The position begins Fall 2023 and will be one day per week, in-person, onsite at our building in Portsmouth, NH, with potential to add additional days.

### Responsibilities

**DUTIES:** Reporting to the Director of Education, duties are as follows:

- Provide weekly 30, 45, or 60 minute individual lessons to cello students of all levels, including beginning cello for ages 7 and up
- Teach lessons in-person and remotely, using video conferencing software, as needed
- Effectively administer and manage studio in collaboration with staff and in adherence to school procedures and policies
- Complete student assessments
- Prepare students for performances each semester
- Participate in recruitment activities inside and outside of the school
- Attend faculty meetings several times a year
- Perform on faculty concerts as a soloist or with other faculty in a chamber music setting

### Qualifications

Bachelor of Music in cello performance or music education required. At least 1 year teaching private cello preferred.

The successful candidate for this position will be subject to a pre-employment background check.
